## OPINIQN

In this application as amended the County of Orange recuests authority to widen the existing crossing at grade of Srookhurst Strect (Crossing No. 6N-27.22) across the Pacific Electric Railway Company Santa Ana IIne. The crossing is presentiy protected by one Standard No. I sign and one Standard No. 3 wigwag. Applicant proposes that two Standard No. 8 Ilashing light signals shall be installed at the crossing. Due to the fact that it will require approximately ten months to secure materials for instaling these signals; that the normal train movements at this crossing consist of one freight and one box motor daily in each direction; that there is no substantial increase in vehicular traffic anticipated at this time and that materiais for an additional No. 3 wigwag are available for immediate installation, it is proposed that, until such time as the new signals can be procured, the improved crossing shali be yrotected by two Scondard No. 3 wigwags (G. O. No. 75-B).

Engineers of the staff have made a field investigation and Iind that Brookhurst Street has been widened and improved up to a point two feet outside the rails and are of the opinion that it would reduce the existing hazard to permit the widening acrose the tracks and thereby eliminate the exioting conctriction in the roadray width at that point. Temporarily the two Standard No. 3 *igwags will provide reasonable protection until ouch time as Standard No. 8 Ilashing light oignalo are available.

The following order will authorize the improverent conaitioned however upon the removal of the wigwags and the substitution therefor of two Standard No. 8 flaching Iqght signals (G.O. No. 75-B) at the earipes possible date and in no case to exceed one year from the date of this order.

The County of Orange 10 authorized to widen the existing crosoing at grade of Brookhurat street with tracks of Pacif1c Electric Railway Company in the vicinity of Garden Grove, Orange County (Crossing No. 6N-27.22). W1dth of the crossing shail be not less than forty fect and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Conetruction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Orden No. 72. Pending the installation of two Standard No. 8 Iashing 21 ght oignals within one year from the date of this order protection shall be by two standard No. $3 \mathrm{wig-}$ wags (General Order No. 75-3).

Construction and maintenance expense shali be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement entered into between the
parties, and a copy of said agreement, approved by Pacific Electric Railway Company shall be filed with the Commission prior to commenceing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty (30) days after completion of widening the crossing pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. Also within thirty (30) days after completion of the installation of the two No. 8 flashing light signals pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
