Application No. 33153 ORDEE The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to relocate the crossing of State Highway Route 41 at grade with a spur track of Southern Pacific Company near Crows Landing, Stanislaus County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. (Present Crossing No. BA-113.6-C. New number BA-113.7-C) Width of crossing shall be not less than the travelled width of highway and grades of approach shall be not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-B). Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Upon completion, Crossing No. BA-113.6-C about 350 feet northerly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time - 1 -

be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
