SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Under date of September 18, 1951, and effective 10 days thereafter, the Commission issued Decision No. 46209 in Application No. 32183 granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Pacific Motor Trucking Company authorizing limited highway common carrier operations. This authority is expressly limited to expire 180 days after the effective date of said Decision No. 46209 or on March 28, 1952.

On March 17, 1952, and effective 20 days thereafter or on April 6, 1952, the Commission rendered its Decision No. 46872 in Application No. 32183 in which it granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing applicant Pacific Motor Trucking Company to conduct highway common carrier operations in the Los Angeles Basin area, including the points covered by the authority granted in said interim order of September 18, 1951.

As the temporary authority will expire by its terms on March 28, 1952, and the permanent authority to be granted by said Decision No. 46872 will not become effective until April 6, 1952, there will be an interval of approximately 10 days during which authority to conduct the operations covered by the certificate granted in the interim order will be lacking unless the temporary

authority is extended by the Commission.

The Commission finds as a fact that public convenience and necessity require that applicant continue without any interruption its highway common carrier operations initiated under said Decision No. 46209 and found to be so required permanently in said Decision No. 46872.

It appearing that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company by said Decision No. 46209 should be extended from March 28 to and including April 6, 1952.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the authority granted by the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by Decision No. 46209, dated September 18, 1951, in Application No. 32183, shall not expire one hundred and eighty days after the effective date thereof or on March 28, 1952, as in said Decision provided but instead said authority shall expire on April 6, 1952.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
