OPINION AND ORDER

Arvin Line, applicant herein, is a passenger stage corporation operating between Bakersfield, Lamont and Arvin.⁽¹⁾ In this application it reports that it has need of additional equipment in order to conduct its transportation service and that it has made arrangements, and now asks permission, to enter into a conditional sales contract providing for the purchase of one 33-passenger Flexible bus at a total cost of \$15,350.40, with a required down payment of \$5,000 and the payment of the balance of \$10,350.40 in 24 monthly installments.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing thereon is not necessary; that the application should be granted, as herein provided; that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for through the execution of the conditional sales contract herein authorized is reasonably required by applicant for the purpose specified herein; and that such purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to

(1) Prior to 1952 applicant's operations extended to Barstow. Under authority granted by Decision No. 46602, dated January 3, 1952, it sold to Hubert L. Mau and Bessie Fern Mau the operative rights between Bakersfield and Barstow and intermediate points, and two Flexible buses, leaving for itself the operations to Arvin, and four buses and one sedan.

operating expenses or to income; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Arvin Line, a corporation, after the effective date hereof and on or before July 31, 1952, may execute a conditional sales contract providing for deferred payments of \$10,350.40 for the purchase of equipment.

2. Within thirty (30) days after execution of said conditional sales contract under the authority herein granted, applicant shall file a copy thereof with the Commission.

3. The authority herein granted will become effective when applicant has paid the minimum fee prescribed by Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars.
