O R D E R

The City of Lompoc is authorized to construct roadways at grade across the White Hills branch line of Southern Pacific Company within the City of Lompoc, Santa Barbara County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos.:

EHA-313.55-D Alley between "A" and "B" Streets  
 EHA-313.6 "B" Street at Hickory Avenue  
 EHA-313.7-D Alley between "B" and "C" Streets  
 EHA-313.85-D Alley between "C" and "D" Streets  
 EHA-313.87 "D" Street  
 EHA-313.95 "E" Street  
 EHA-314.0-D Alley between "E" and "F" Streets

Applicant is also authorized to construct an alley between "D" and "E" Streets, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. EHA-313.9.

Crossing No. EHA-314.0-D is authorized for a period not to exceed one (1) year from the effective date of this order, and shall be abandoned and closed by the City of Lompoc thereafter.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two (2) feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Widths of crossings shall be not less than 24 feet in street

areas and 20 feet in alley areas. Grades of approach shall not exceed the grades as shown on prints attached to the application. Construction in the alley areas shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 and in the street areas to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign at each alley intersection and by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs at each street intersection (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion of each crossing pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
