O R D E R

City of Redwood City, San Mateo County, is authorized to construct a public road at grade across the Redwood Harbor spur of Southern Pacific Company and two adjacent side tracks in that City, at the location described in the application and in accordance with agreement between applicant and Southern Pacific Company, copy of which is attached to the application. Crossing shall be identified as Crossing No. E-28.7-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Said crossing is required to serve the Port of Redwood City and is urgently needed to carry on the port business. Request has been made that this authority be made effective as of its date. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
