In the Matter of the application of THE WESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY for authority to construct a spur track across Louise Avenue in the County of San Joaquin, State of California.

ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Louise Avenue near Lathrop, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4-83.7-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-B).

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
