OPINION AND ORDER

California Parlor Car Tours Company, applicant herein, is engaged in the business of operating motor coaches for the transportation of passengers within the State of California. It has filed this application pursuant to the provisions of Section 6 of General Order No. 101 for approval by the Commission of agreements of indemnity.

The application shows that the company has a certificate of insurance providing for primary indemnification with Lloyd's of London against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for bodily injuries to or death of one person in the amount of \$50,000, for bodily injuries to or death of all persons injured or killed in any one accident in the amount of \$50,000, and for property damage in the amount of \$50,000. The application further shows that the company has excess indemnification with Lloyd's against liability for bodily injuries or death in excess of \$50,000 but not to exceed \$1,000,000, and that it has entered into an agreement of indemnity with Pacific Greyhound Lines, the owner of all its outstanding shares of stock, whereby that company has agreed to indemnify it against liability for injury to or death of one person up to \$10,000, for injury to or death of all persons injured or

killed in any one accident up to \$100,000, and for property damage up to \$5,000. A copy of each of the several instruments has been filed with this proceeding.


The Commission has given consideration to this matter and is of the opinion that the indemnification provided should afford security for the protection of the public, within the limits prescribed by the general order, without affecting the stability and permanency of the company's operations, and that its request accordingly should be granted, as herein provided; therefore,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:


1. The Commission hereby approves the agreements filed in this application as Exhibits A, B and C, together with a renewal, or renewals thereof, providing California Parlor Car Tours Company with indemnification against liability for bodily injuries and property damage.


2. This order is effective upon the date hereof.


