O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Ortega for more than two years and that its continued maintenance as a Class "B" station, at which freight of carloads only will be received or delivered, is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Ortega, County of Santa Barbara, to a Class "E" station at which freight will not be handled; to change its station records; and to cancel all freight tariffs and schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
