O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional side track at grade across El Capitan Way in Merced County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-131.8. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the widened portion of the road indicated on the print attached to the application, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 wigwag signals (G.O. No. 75-B), which shall be synchronized with traffic signals when the latter are installed at the adjacent State Highway intersection by the State Division of Highways. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
