ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing that in October of 1948, by Decision No. 42091 in the above proceeding, a certificate authorizing the establishment of certain passenger stage operations was issued to CARL WILLIAM FISHER, doing business as Laguna Motor Tours; that in December of 1950 a purported transfer of said certificate was made by Carl William Fisher to Wayne Wilhite; that no authorization for such purported transfer was sought or obtained from the Commission; that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage has been filed with the Commission, as required by General Order No. 101; and that the passenger stage service in question has been discontinued for a substantial period of time without any authorization to suspend or discontinue such operations; therefore, it is found that Carl William Fisher is no longer conducting and has abandoned said passenger stage operation.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate issued to Carl William Fisher by Decision No. 42091 in the above proceeding is hereby

revoked, and all effective tariffs and time tables on file are hereby cancelled.

The Secretary is directed to cause certified copies of this order to be served upon Carl William Fisher and upon Wayne Wilhite.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon Carl William Fisher, unless said Carl William Fisher, before such effective date, shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is had and a further order issued.
