## ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 45521 Guido Simonini, applicant herein was authorized to acquire a passenger stage operative right authorizing the transportation of passengers and express between Fort Bragg and Little River Mirport. In this proceeding he requests the Commission to authorize him to discontinue that service.

According to the application the total gross operating revenue derived from the transportation of passengers and express for a four-month period ending August 31, 1951 amounted to \$207.57 and the total out-of-pocket expenses incurred amounted to \$303.88. The expenses incurred included no allowance for depreciation of equipment nor for compensation to the applicant. Applicant has subsequently reported that during that period he transported a total of 171 passengers on 71 trips and operated 2,414 miles. Applicant further reports that he ceased the operation during December, 1951 and has conducted no service since that time. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED, that the operative right created by Decision No. 42151, in Application No. 29530, acquired by applicant herein pursuant to Decision No. 45521, in Application No. 32245, is

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hereby revoked and annulled, and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Guido Simonini are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
