 certain intermediate points.

O P I N I O N

Applicant now is authorized to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Westwood Village, Culver City and Beverly Hills Hotel, on the one hand, and the Hollywood Park Race Track and Santa Anita Race Track, on the other hand, pursuant to Decisions Nos. 43299, 43862 and 44213. It also conducts a seasonal operation to the Tournament of Roses in Pasadena and to the Rose Bowl Football Game, under the last-named decision. Recently it acquired, pursuant to Decision No. 46583, an additional passenger service for hire between Santa Monica and the Los Angeles International Airport and the aforementioned race tracks.

By this application authority is requested to transport passengers and their baggage between the Los Angeles International Airport, on the one hand, and Beverly Hills, California, on the other hand, serving four named intermediate points along applicant's present route. This service will be restricted to persons destined to or originating at the Los Angeles Airport and traveling to or from the following points:

Beverly Hills Hotel; Pacific Electric Railway Company depot situated at Santa Monica Boulevard and Canon Drive, Beverly Hills; Beverly-Wilshire Hotel; Truman's Restaurant situated at Wilshire Boulevard and Westwood Boulevard, West Los Angeles; and a point near the intersection of Duquesne Avenue and Washington Boulevard in Culver City.

The proposed fares, which include tax, will be \$2.00 between the airport and the Beverly Hills Hotel, Pacific Electric depot and the Beverly-Wilshire Hotel; \$1.75 between the airport and Truman's Restaurant; and \$1.25 between the Culver City point and the airport.

Applicant will operate on an on-call basis between 6:00 A.M. and midnight seven days per week, and will use limousines.

It is alleged that there is not now any similar service available to the public, and, as justification for its request, applicant states that several business and civic organizations have asked for the proposed service; that it is needed because of the number of persons traveling by air who have businesses or reside in the vicinity of the points proposed to be served.

The application is not opposed, and it appearing that public convenience and necessity so require it will be granted.

O R D E R

Application having been filed, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and having found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and it hereby is, granted to Beverly Hills Garage, Inc., a corporation, doing business as Beverly Motor Livery, authorizing the establishment and operation of a passenger stage service, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between the Beverly Hills Hotel, Beverly Hills, California, and the Los Angeles

International Airport and intermediate points hereinafter named, subject to the following condition:

Applicant shall transport only persons destined to or originating from the Los Angeles International Airport, from and to the following points:

Beverly Hills Hotel; Pacific Electric Railway Company depot situated at Santa Monica Boulevard and Canon Drive, Beverly Hills; Beverly-Wilshire Hotel; Truman's Restaurant situated at Wilshire Boulevard and Westwood Boulevard, West Los Angeles; and a point near the intersection of Duquesne Avenue and Washington Boulevard in Culver City.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, there shall be compliance with the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty (30) days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty (60) days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.
- (c) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such at any time, Beverly Hills Garage, Inc. shall conduct said passenger stage operations over and along the following-described route:

Beginning at the Beverly Hills Hotel at Sunset Boulevard and Canon Drive, Beverly Hills, California, thence along Canon Drive, Santa Monica Boulevard, Rodeo Drive, Wilshire Boulevard, El Camino Drive, Charleville Boulevard, Rodeo Drive, Wilshire Boulevard, Westwood Boulevard, National Boulevard, Hughes Avenue, Duquesne Avenue, Jefferson Boulevard, Sepulveda Boulevard, Manchester Avenue, Airport Boulevard, Century Boulevard to the International Airport.

Applicant is authorized to turn its motor vehicles at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, or in accordance with local traffic rules.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
