OPINION AND ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Decision No. 16333, dated March 30, 1926, on Application No. 11887, applicant was given a certificate of public convenience and necessity to perform a service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of lumber consigned from or to the Hammond Lumber Company under contracts therefor, and also for the transportation of fertilizer, between Los Angeles and the Los Angeles harbor district, and Pomona and Ontario, over described routes.

By the subject application, applicant seeks authority to abandon such service and cancel rates, rules and regulations set forth in his tariff. He alleges that for more than twenty-five years he has been authorized to provide service as a highway common carrier as set forth above, that at the present time no patrons are using his facilities, that he has not been called upon to conduct any service as a highway common carrier for many years, and that he does not expect any demands upon his services within the foreseeable future.

Upon the allegations of the verified application, the Commission finds that the applicant's services and operations

as a highway common carrier pursuant to the authority granted by Decision No. 16333, dated March 30, 1926, have been discontinued and abandoned, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the above-mentioned entire operative right of C. E. Hamilton to, from, or between the points and places and via the routes hereinbefore more specifically referred to and described, be and the same hereby is revoked, and all effective tariffs and timetables are hereby cancelled and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
