SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant has been authorized to deviate from the established minimum rates in connection with the transportation of property for General Mills, Inc. - Sperry Division between various points in southern California. The authority is scheduled to expire May 11, 1952. Permission is now sought to continue to observe the presently authorized basis for a further one-year period.

The verified supplemental application alleges that the conditions surrounding the transportation in question which justified deviation from the minimum rates generally still obtain; and that, while operations under the authorized basis have been conducted at some profit, negotiations are under way to increase applicant's charges for the service involved.

In the circumstances, applicant's allegations and supporting representations are not fully persuasive that the sought one-year extension of the present basis should be granted without further investigation. Meanwhile, to avoid lapse of all authority to charge less than the regular minimum rates while the matter is under consideration, the continuation of the present authority for a sixty-day period beyond its scheduled expiration date will be authorized.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted Ira P. Lamb Company by Decision No. 45427 of March 6, 1951, as amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to July 10, 1952, unless sooner changed or further extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective May 11, 1952.
