REED for authority to extend the certificates of public convenience and necessity, held by G. W. SUNDBORG, defined by Decision No. 41589 from Pinecrest and Strawberry to Dardanelle.

ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing that in May of 1949, by Decision No. 42881 in the above proceeding Thomas J. Reed was authorized to acquire from G. W. Sundborg a highway common carrier certificate between Pinecrest and Strawberry, on the one hand, and Dardanelle and intermediate points, on the other hand; that in March of 1951 a purported transfer of said certificate was made by Thomas J. Reed to Patrick E. Clarke; that no authorization for such purported transfer was sought or obtained from the Commission; that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage is on file with the Commission, as required by General Order No. 100; and that the highway common carrier service in question has been discontinued for a substantial period of time without any authorization to suspend or discontinue such operations; therefore, it is found that Thomas J. Reed is no longer conducting and has abandoned.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate acquired by Thomas J. Reed pursuant to Decision No. 42881 in the above proceeding is hereby revoked, and all effective tariffs and time-tables on file are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause certified copies of this order to be served upon Thomas J. Reed and upon Patrick E. Clarke.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon Thomas J. Reed, unless said Thomas J. Reed, before such effective date, shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is had and a further order issued.
