BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of GUY GLASS, doing business as GUY GLASS TRUCKING, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile freight service as a petroleum irregular route carrier, between all points in the State of California in Ventura, Los Angeles, Orange, San Diego, Riverside, San Bernardino and Kern Counties, by reason of operations conducted on and after September 1, 1949, under Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit issued by the Public Utilities Commission.

ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing that in September of 1950, by Decision No. 44770 in the above proceeding, a certificate to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier was issued to GUY GLASS, doing business as Guy Glass Trucking; that said Guy Glass has advised the Commission's staff that he has ceased operations, sold his trucking equipment, and does not intend to operate under the above certificate; that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage is on file with the Commission, as required by General Order No. 100; and that the operation in question has been discontinued for a substantial period of time without any authorization to suspend or discontinue such operation; therefore, it is found that Guy Glass is no longer conducting and has abandoned said petroleum irregular route operation.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate issued to Guy Glass pursuant to Decision No. 44770 in the above proceeding is hereby re-

voked, and all effective tariffs and time-tables on file are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Guy Glass.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon Guy Glass, unless, before such effective date, he shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is had and a further order issued.
