FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 45783, dated May 29, 1951, the Commission, among other things, authorized Hills Transportation Co. to sell and transfer operative rights and properties and authorized Consolidated Freightways, Inc. to incur indebtedness in the principal amount of \$69,000 on or before October 1, 1951, for the purpose of acquiring said rights and properties. Thereafter, a petition for rehearing was filed by certain other carriers which was not passed upon until April 22, 1952, when the Commission entered its Decision No. 47030 denying such petition for rehearing.

In view of the fact that said petition for rehearing was not acted upon until after the date fixed in the original Decision No. 45783, it is necessary to enter a supplemental order extending the time within which the companies may exercise the authority granted by that decision; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

l. The time within which Hills Transportation Co. may sell and transfer operative rights and properties and Consolidated Freightways, Inc. may incur indebtedness under the

authority granted by Decision No. 45783, dated May 29, 1951, is hereby extended to and including June 30, 1952.

2. This first supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
