## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 47172, dated May 16, 1952 in the above-entitled application, the Commission granted the Pacific Gas and Electric Company a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a public utility gas plant and distribution system in and around Waterford, Stanislaus County, under the condition that the certificate shall not become effective until the date of transfer of properties from Mr. Cooper to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company.

The company must install some new pipes in the territory now certificated to Mr. Cooper prior to the date of transfer in order that the transfer may take place. Under the certificate as provided by Decision No. 47172 the company does not have authority to construct plant in Waterford prior to the transfer date and requests amendment of the certificate to permit such construction. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first paragraph on page 10 of Decision No. 47172 in the above-entitled matter, dated May 16, 1952, is amended to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and the same is hereby granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to construct and operate a public utility gas plant and distribution system in and around Waterford, Stanislaus County, and between Empire and Waterford, and to exercise the rights and privileges under Ordinance No. 266 of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus in such areas, provided, however, that this certificate shall not become effective for that portion of the operations involving sale of gas until the transfer of properties herein authorized has been consummated."

In all other respects Decision No. 47172 shall remain in full force and effect.
