O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Del Monte during the past several years and that continued maintenance thereof as a freight station is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Del Monte, County of Monterey, from Class "A" to Class "E" or station at which freight will not be handled; to change station records accordingly; and to cancel all freight tariffs applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after the reclassification as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
