ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

EVELYN GREENE having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that complainant's telephone service at 12341 East Ferris Road, El Monte, California, under number FOrrest 8-2244, was disconnected by a member of the Sheriff's office under the claim that complainant was then using such telephone facilities for book-making purposes, which charge was and is untrue; that defendant has refused to restore said telephone facilities; that complainant has suffered and will suffer irreparable injury and great hardship as a result of being deprived of telephone facilities; and that complainant did not use and does not now intend to use such telephone facilities as an instrumentality to violate the law, nor in aiding or abetting such violation; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby directed to restore telephone service to complainant pending hearing on said complaint or further order by this Commission thereon, such service to be furnished pursuant to defendant's filed tariff rates and rules applicable thereto. The complaint will be

set for hearing before such Commissioner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary is directed as follows:

1. To cause a certified copy of this order, together with a copy of the complaint herein, to be served upon The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply to said complaint within ten (10) days after such service.

2. To cause copies of this order to be mailed to complainant and to complainant's attorney.

3. To cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to the parties at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing herein.
