## Decision No. 47216

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority (a) to reclassify its Class "A" non-agency Station at Whitney, in the County of Placer, State of California, to a Class "E" non-agency station, and (b) abandon and remove a spur track approximately 508 feet in length located at said station.

## ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Whitney during the past two years and that its continued maintenance as a freight station is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Whitney, County of Placer, from Class "A" to Class "E", or a station at which freight will not be handled; to remove a spur track at said station; to change its station records accordingly; and to cancel all freight tariffs applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after reclassification and abandonment as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
