## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 47099, dated May 5, 1952, the Commission, among other things, authorized San Jose Hills Water Company to issue a promissory note in the principal amount of not exceeding \$300,000 and to execute a mortgage of chattels.

It now appears that the mortgage which applicant proposes to execute will be a lien on both real and personal property, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph 6 of the order in Decision No. 47099, dated May 5, 1952, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6. San Jose Hills Water Company, after the effective date hereof and on or before August 31, 1952, may issue a promissory note in the principal amount of not exceeding \$300,000 pursuant to the terms of the loan agreement dated April 1, 1952, filed as Exhibit B in Application No. 33348, and use the proceeds for the purposes set forth in said application, and may execute a mortgage in, or substantially in, the same form as that filed as Exhibit D in said application.

This first supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
