ORDER DENYING REHEARING AND AMENDING DECISION

A petition for rehearing with respect to Decision No. 46966 in the above-entitled matter having been filed by Highway Transport, Inc., and Merchants Express Corporation, and separate petitions for rehearing with respect thereto having been filed by Delta Lines, Inc., and by J. A. Nevis Trucking, Inc., the Commission having carefully considered all of said petitions and each and every allegation contained therein, and being of opinion that no good cause for the granting of a rehearing is therein made to appear,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that each of said petitions is hereby denied.

It appearing that the application herein, as amended, stated that applicant thereby requested authority as a highway common carrier to transport general commodities, except household goods, petroleum products in bulk, livestock, fresh fruits and vegetables, and commodities requiring refrigeration, and that by inadvertence the opinion in said decision, in stating the commodities which applicant sought authority to transport, omitted to except livestock and that by inadvertence the order in said decision omitted to except livestock from the commodities for the transportation of which a certificate of public convenience and necessity was thereby granted, and that the said omissions should be corrected,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the word "livestock" and a comma are hereby inserted immediately after the words and comma "petroleum products in bulk," in the first paragraph of said opinion and in paragraph numbered "(1)" of the said order.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
