ORDER DENYING REHEARING AND CORRECTING DECISION

A petition for rehearing of Decision No. 46920 in the above-entitled matter having been filed by Highway Transport, Inc., and Merchants Express Corporation, and a petition for rehearing having been filed by Beckman Express & Warehouse Co., the applicant herein, the Commission having carefully considered said petitions and every allegation contained in each petition, and being of opinion that no good cause for the granting of a rehearing is therein made to appear,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that each of said petitions is hereby denied.

It appearing that one of the requests contained in Application No. 31797, as amended, herein, was for the grant of a certificate for the transportation of general commodities, except uncrated used household goods, liquids in bulk, livestock and fresh fruits and vegetables, and that by inadvertence the order in said Decision No. 46920, granting a certificate for transportation of general commodities, omitted to except livestock, and that such omission should be corrected,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a comma and the word "livestock" are hereby inserted immediately after the words "liquids in bulk" in the ordering paragraph

numbered "(1)" in said Decision No. 46920.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
