ORDER

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Rivergrade Road, a County highway, at separated grades under the track of Pacific Electric Railway Company near Baldwin Park, Los Angeles County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the application to be identified as Crossing No. 6T-15.34-B. Clearances shall conform to provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto and a copy of said agreement together with plans of the crossing at separated grades approved by Pacific Electric Railway Company shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if

above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
