O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 135 at grade across the Visalia Branch of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company near Corcoran, Kings County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2V-1.0. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 48 feet and grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals. (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. Applicant is ready to let contract for the construction of this highway and therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
