ORDER OF TERMINATION
OF INVESTIGATION

This investigation was instituted by the Commission on February 19, 1952 to determine the reasonableness of the tariff changes proposed by California Electric Power Company under its Advice No. 45. In reviewing tariff sheets: Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 748-E to 789-E, inclusive, it appeared that the conditions may be more restrictive than those contained in the present schedules; *Q 12* therefore, the tariff sheets were suspended and public hearing ordered.

Before the date for the public hearing was set the California Electric Power Company on May 29, 1952 filed application for cancellation of Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 748-E to 789-E, inclusive. The application states: "since date of filing it has become apparent to California Electric Power Company that several of the changes requested under Advice Letter No. 45 may be broader than necessary and that certain others should be modified to reflect their purpose with greater accuracy. It would appear, therefore, that unnecessary investigation may be avoided and the interests of

orderly procedure best served by permitting your applicant to cancel
the tariff sheets and tariff changes filed under Advice Letter
237m No. 45." Good cause appearing^g therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said tariff sheets are cancelled
and the investigation is terminated.
