ORDER AMENDING DECISION AND DENYING REHEARING

PACIFIC FREIGHT LINES and PACIFIC FREIGHT LINES EXPRESS having filed a petition for rehearing respecting Decision No. 47047, and JAMES H. CARR and CHARLES A. CARR, doing business as OXNARD TRUCKING SERVICE, having filed a petition for reconsideration of said decision on the record as made, the Commission having considered said petitions, and each of the allegations therein, and being of the opinion that no good cause has been shown for the granting of either of said petitions, but that the decision should be amended to authorize the transportation of returned and rejected shipments, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph (1) (a) of Decision No. 47047 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following language:

"and for the transportation of returned and rejected shipments from said northern territory to said southern territory."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitions herein be, and the same are,
hereby denied.
