O P I N I O N

Willis M. Kleinenbroich requests authority to discontinue passenger stage service between Riverbank and Modesto via Defense Plants, Incorporated. It appears that the right to operate between such points was created by Decision No. 35846, dated October 13, 1942, in Application No. 25267, for the purpose of serving Defense Plants, Incorporated, situated southerly of Riverbank on Claus Road.

Decision No. 38193, dated September 12, 1945, upon the ground that the wartime manufacture of aluminum at Defense Plants, Incorporated, had been temporarily discontinued, ordered the suspension of service between Modesto and Riverbank until September 1, 1946. Such decision further directed applicant to request revocation of such operative right, upon expiration of said suspension period, if there had been no demand for reestablishment of the service.

Applicant alleges that there have been no requests for reinstatement of the suspended service.

Under the circumstances here shown, it is the opinion of the Commission that the application should be granted.

ORDER

An application having been filed and the Commission being of the opinion that the authority requested should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That Willis M. Kleinenbroich is authorized to discontinue all service between Modesto and Riverbank and intermediate points, via Defense Plants, Incorporated and the operating authority therefor granted by Decision No. 35846, dated October 13, 1942, is cancelled and annulled.
- (2) That within sixty (60) days from the effective date thereof and on not less than five (5) days notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall file appropriate tariffs and timetables reflecting the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
