O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 5 at separated grades under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company and the Western Pacific Railroad Company, near Warm Springs, Alameda County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the amended application filed March 14, 1952, to be identified as Crossings No. DA-36.1-B and No. 4G-6.6-B respectively. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with agreements entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreements, together with plans of said crossings approved by the respective railroad companies, shall be filed with the Commission within one hundred and eighty days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. As applicant is

prepared to let contract for construction immediately, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
