## OPINION AND ORDER

In the above application, Southern California Gas Company and Pacific Gas and Electric Company request an order of this Commission, under Section 851 of the Public Utilities Code, authorizing Southern California Gas Company to sell and Pacific Gas and Electric Company to buy certain gas distribution facilities located in territory recently annexed to the City of Bakersfield, California. A detail of the facilities to be purchased is set forth in an agreement dated March 5, 1952, attached to and made a part of the application as Exhibit "A".

Southern California Gas Company, hereinafter referred to as "Southern", is engaged in the purchase, distribution and sale of gas in the central and southern portions of the State of California, including territory contiguous to the City of Bakersfield, California, and territory recently annexed to that City. Pacific Gas and Electric Company, hereinafter referred to as "Pacific", is engaged in the purchase, distribution and sale of gas in the central and northern portions of the State of California, including territory within the City of Bakersfield, California.

- 2. Upon selling to Pacific Gas and Electric Company the aforesaid distribution facilities, Southern California Gas Company may cease furnishing gas service in the territory supplied by means of said facilities.
- 3. Within thirty days after acquiring the aforesaid distribution facilities, Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall file with the Commission a copy of the deed or other instrument under which it acquires and holds title to said distribution facilities and shall advise the Commission of the date upon which it acquired said distribution facilities and the date on which it took possession of the same.
- 4. The authority herein granted shall not be construed to be a finding of value of the properties herein authorized to be transferred.
