ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

On November 6, 1951 the Commission issued an order directing telephone corporations to file a specified rule or show cause on March 12, 1952 why such rule should not be filed. $\frac{1}{}$ After hearing and submission, and by Decision No. 46914, the proceeding was reopened for further hearing, the petition of California State Hotel Association for leave to intervene was granted, and the effective date of all rules filed by respondent telephone corporations pursuant to the order of November 6, 1951 or pursuant to Decision No. 46914, was suspended until August 9, 1952, unless otherwise thereafter ordered.

Hearing in the reopened proceeding, held on June 11, 1952, was adjourned to August 25, 1952. It appearing that the matter will not be ready for submission prior to the expiration of the present period of suspension,

1/ The rule reads as follows:

[&]quot;Telephone exchange, message unit, and message toll telephone services are furnished to hotels, apartment houses, and clubs upon the condition that use of the services by guests, tenants, members, and others shall not be made subject to any charge by any hotel, apartment house, or club in addition to the telephone exchange, message unit, and message toll telephone rates and charges of the telephone company, except as specifically provided for in the tariff schedules of the telephone company."
