O P I N I O N

San Bernardino Valley Transit Company operates as a passenger stage corporation in San Bernardino and vicinity, and also between San Bernardino and Colton under authority from this Commission. ⁽¹⁾ By this application it seeks authority to effect three short extensions.

The first extension requested is along Third Street in the County of San Bernardino between the intersections of Third Street with Del Rosa Avenue and Victoria Avenue, a distance of approximately one and eight-tenths miles. This extension will enable applicant to give service to and from Norton Air Force Base Gate No. 5, located on Third Street in the proposed extension. Applicant's application alleges that the personnel of the base has increased since authority was granted to serve along Third Street, and that the commanding general of the base has requested the extended service.

The second extension proposed is from the intersection of Baseline Street and Muscott Street along Muscott Street and Ninth Street to the intersection of Ninth Street

and Western Avenue, all in the City of San Bernardino. This extension is approximately six-tenths of a mile in length, and is sought to enable applicant to provide service to a 300-unit housing development containing approximately 1,500 persons, and situated along or near Muscott Street between Ninth Street and Eleventh Street.

The third extension is between the intersection of Twenty-seventh Street and Davidson Avenue, along Davidson Avenue, Thirty-first Street, Mt. Vernon Avenue, and Colima Road to its intersection with Davidson Avenue. This extension is approximately one and one-tenth miles in length, is entirely in the City of San Bernardino and is sought to enable applicant to provide service to approximately 300 persons residing in the vicinity of Davidson Avenue and Thirty-first Street.

No other carriers are affected by the proposed extensions. The City Council of San Bernardino, by resolution of June 16, 1952 has approved the proposed changes. After consideration of the matter, we find that the proposed extensions are required by public convenience and necessity. Accordingly, the request will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been made in the above-entitled matter, the Commission being fully advised and having found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and it hereby is, granted to San Bernardino Valley Transit Company, a corporation, authorizing it to establish and operate a service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers (a) between the intersection of Third Street and Del Rosa Avenue, on the one hand, and the intersection of Third Street and Victoria Avenue, on the other hand, all in the County of San Bernardino, California; (b) between the intersection of Baseline Street and Muscott Street, on the one hand, and the intersection of Ninth Street and Western Avenue, on the other hand, all in the City of San Bernardino, California; (c) from the intersection of Twenty-seventh Street and Davidson Avenue, via Davidson Avenue, Thirty-first Street, Mt. Vernon Avenue, and Colima Road to its intersection with Davidson Avenue, all in the City of San Bernardino, California, with the right to serve all intermediate points, as extensions and enlargements of, and to be consolidated with applicant's present operating rights.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, the following service regulations shall be complied with:

- (a) Within thirty (30) days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty (60) days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five (5)

days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.

(c) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such at any time, San Bernardino Valley Transit Company, a corporation, shall conduct said passenger stage operations over and along the following-described routes:

1. Between the intersection of Third Street and Del Rosa Avenue and the intersection of Third Street and Victoria Avenue, over and along Third Street.
2. Between the intersection of Baseline Street and Muscott Avenue and the intersection of Ninth Street and Western Avenue, over and along Muscott Avenue and Ninth Street.
3. Between the intersection of Twenty-seventh Street and Davidson Avenue and the intersection of Colima Road and Davidson Avenue, over and along Davidson Avenue, Thirty-first Street, Mt. Vernon Avenue and Colima Road.

Applicant is authorized to turn its motor vehicles at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, or in accordance with local traffic rules.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
