BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of
 the State of California, Department
 of Public Works, for an order
 authorizing construction of a cross-
 ing at separated grades and the
 abandonment of an existing crossing
 at grade of tracks of the Southern
 Pacific Company with State Highway
 Route VII-Ven-2-B, sometimes referred
 to as "Camarillo Overhead" in Ventura
 County, California.

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct the "Camarillo Overhead" (State Highway Route VII-Ven-2-B) at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company's Coast Line in the County of Ventura, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit "B") attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-416.7-A.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

During construction of the separation structure, applicant is temporarily authorized to deviate from clearances prescribed by General Order No. 26-D to the extent of a minimum

vertical clearance of 22 feet and a minimum horizontal clearance of 8 feet, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Bulletins shall be issued by Southern Pacific Company and copies furnished the Commission, advising train crews of the existence of the impaired clearance conditions.
- (2) Warning signs and tell-tales shall be installed at appropriate distances approaching the structure from either direction on the main line and passing track.
- (3) Enginemen shall not work steam while passing under the structure during the hours work on the overpass is in progress.

Upon completion, Crossing No. E-416.6, located about 250 feet to the south, shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two (2) years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Inasmuch as the Department of Public Works is anxious to proceed with this work at the earliest possible date, applicant requests that the Order be made effective on its

date. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
