Southern Pacific Company having waived protest, IT IS ORDERED that approval is hereby granted for the display of distinctive "exempt signs" (Vehicle Code Section 576(d); General Order No. 98), at the following spur track crossings in the County of Los Angeles:

Such signs shall comply with General Order No. 98 and shall be erected and maintained by the proper authorities. If any sign is removed, or the view thereof obstructed, vehicles carrying passengers for hire must come to a full and complete stop before passing over the crossing. Within thirty (30) days after erection of such signs, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This approval does not exempt any vehicle operator from the observance of any provision of the Vehicle Code, and shall become void if signs are not displayed

within one (1) year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Approval may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
