The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company discloses that no carload freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Wilfred for more than two years and its continued maintenance as a freight station handling carload shipments is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Wilfred, County of Sonoma, from Class "C" to Class "D" or a station at which carload freight will not be handled; to remove a side track at said station; to change its station records accordingly; and to cancel all applicable tariffs on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after reclassification and abandonment as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
