O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate its Placerville Branch main track at grade across Union Street in the City of Placerville, El Dorado County, identified as Crossing No. AH-149.6, to the location described in the application. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Upon completion the existing crossing of the same identifying number of said main branch track and the two adjacent side tracks shall be removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the Department of Public Works is reconstructing State Highway in the vicinity and requires the immediate removal of existing tracks. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
