## OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, United Towing Co. sceks a For-Hire Vessel permit to transport fuel oils, including Diesel fuel oil, in bulk, for the Standard Oil Company, between points within the harbors of Los Angeles, San Pedro, and Long Beach. Eight barges, varying in capacity from 3,143 barrels to 11,616 barrels, will be used by applicant in fulfilling its contractual obligations with Standard Oil Company.

It appears that the application meets the requirements of Section 4533 of the Public Utilities Code, and that a public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a For-Mire Vessel permit be and it is hereby issued to United Towing Co. to operate the vessels described in this application between points within the harbors of Los Angeles, San Pedro, and Long Beach, via all navigable routes, for the transportation of fuel oils, including Diesel fuel oil, in bulk, for Standard Oil Company of California.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in providing the service authorized herein, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- 1. File written acceptance of the permit herein granted, within thirty (30) days after the effective date hereof.
- 2. Within sixty (60) days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, file in triplicate a tariff containing rates, charges and regulations conforming with those filed with the application and specifying the shipper to be served as herein authorized.
