OPINION AND ORDER OF REVOCATION

In this proceeding, Arnold W. Ogle and Vard A. Ogle, co-partners doing business as Ogle Bros., request the Commission to authorize them to discontinue highway common carrier operations for the transportation of liquefied petroleum products in tank trucks from Petaluma and Santa Rosa to Covelo. The operative right involved was created by Decision No. 46858 in Application No. 32833.

As justification for the authority sought, it is stated in the application that the only service which applicants are providing between those points for the transportation of petroleum products is provided for one firm only, which can be adequately handled by them under their petroleum contract carrier permit.

Subsequently, by letter dated June 20, 1952, applicants report that they have sold all of their tank truck equipment. It thus appears that they are no longer conducting any operations under the certificate above referred to. Therefore, such operative right will be revoked and annulled. No public hearing appears to be necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative right granted to Arnold W. Ogle and Vard A. Ogle, doing business as Ogle Bros., by paragraph

(5) of the order in Decision No. 46858 in Application No. 32833, is hereby revoked and annulled, and all effective tariffs and time-tables on file with the Commission in the name of Arnold W. Ogle and Vard A. Ogle, are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20)-days after the date hereof.
