OPINION AND ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, asks authority to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement, dated May 26, 1952, with Paradise Irrigation District. Said agreement relates to the delivery of a quantity of water by the company not required for the generation of power, and in no event in excess of 500 acre-feet, as such water may from time to time be available therefor in the company's Hendricks Canal in Butte County, during a period ending November 1, 1952, at the rate of \$10 per acre-foot.

The district is in urgent need of additional water to supply its users during the remainder of the 1952 season.

The contract contains a provision that it shall, at all times, be subject to change or modification by the Commission in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

The Commission having considered the request of applicant and being of the opinion that the application should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, be and it is authorized to carry out the terms of the written contract, dated May 26, 1952, with Paradise Irrigation District, and to render the service described under the terms, charges and conditions stated therein, subject to the following conditions:

1. That applicant shall file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this order, two (2) certified copies of the contract as executed, together with a statement of the date on which it is deemed to have become effective.
2. That applicant shall notify this Commission of the date of termination of said contract within thirty (30) days after said date of termination.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
