O R D E R

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct an additional side track at grade across 137th Avenue and 143rd Avenue near Estudillo, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossings No. 4-15.9 and 4-16.3. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenues now graded but not less than 24 feet with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection at Crossing No. 4-15.9 (137th Avenue) shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Protection at Crossing No. 4-16.3 (143rd Avenue) shall be by two existing Standard No. 8 flashing light signals, one of which is to be relocated as shown in the application.

Expense of construction, relocation and alteration shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement between the applicant and the County. Should the parties fail to agree the Commission will allocate such costs by subsequent order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
