O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across a county road near Lathrop, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. D-80.64-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two reflectorized Standard No. 1 or Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry to be served by said spur track requires service at the earliest possible time and requests

that this authority be made effective immediately; therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
