Application No. 33537 extend operations as a passenger stage corporation.

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Applicants are presentiy engaged as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the pubilc Utilitios code, In San Mateo County, California, within and botwe on the municipalities of Burlingame, Hillsborough, San Mateo and Belmont undor authority of this commission. The aboverontitied application iequests authority to extond operations by adding the following route:

Comencing at the intersection of Third Avenue and South Norfolk Street to Dale Avenue, Anna Stroet, and Cottage Avenue to South Norfolk Street.

As justification for the roquest applicant alleges that the aree proposed to be served is a relatively new development. There are said to be 897 homes occupied in the South Shoreviow tract and 1,024 homes will probably be occupiod in July 1952. In connection with applicants' request for an increase in rates in Application No. 32887 the staff of this Comission has rocommended that this extension bo mado at an early dato.

Applicant proposos no now equipmont or facilities and the rates as now ostabilshed or as incroased as requested will apply to this extension 11 authorizcd. Applicant is financially able to provido this service. The commission finds as a fact that public convenience and necessity requiro this proposed service. The application will, therefore, be granted. A public hearing is not necossary.

## ORDER

Application as above entitlod having been made, the
Comission being fully advised and finding that pubilc convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:
(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necossity is hereby granted to Ray Withers and Andrew C. Byrd, a copartnorship doing business as San Mateo rransit authorizing the establishment and servico as a passenger stage corporation, as dofined in section 226 of the Public Utilities code between the intersection of East Third Avenue and South Norfolk Streot on tho one hand and on the other band the intersection of Dale ivenuc and South Norfolk Street and intermediate points in San Mateo, California, as an enlargoment of, and to bo consolidated with, their oporative rights in this area.
(2) That in providing sorvice pursuant to the cortificate berein granted, applicant shall comply with and observo the following service regulations:
(a) Within thirty (30) days aftor the effectivo dato hereof applicants shall file a written acceptance of the cortificato herein grantod.
(b) Within sixty (60) days aftor the effective date hereof and upon not loss than ifvo (5) days' notice to the commission and the pubilc applicont shall establish the service heroin authorized and file in triplicato, and concurrently make effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.
(c) Subject to tho authority of this commission to change or modify it by further order applicants shall conduct operations pursuant to the cortificato heroin grantod over and along the following stroots.

Along South Norfolk Stroot between East Third fronue and Dole Avcnue. Also along Dalo Avenue, Anna Street and Cottage Avenue for one block north eastorly of said south Norfolk Streot.
foplicants are authorizod to turn thoir vehicies at termini and intermediato points, in either direction, at intersections of
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streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersection, or in accordance with local traffic rules.
