O P I N I O N

Applicant, Motor Street Car Service, presently rendering a passenger stage service between points within Santa Rosa and between Santa Rosa and the Lewis District Sonoma County Hospital, Talbot District, South Park District and intermediate points, requests authority to extend one of its existing routes along Bennett Avenue from Santa Rosa Avenue to Brookwood Avenue.

In justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that the proposed extension would alleviate difficulties experienced due to traffic congestion in the immediate area of the new Veterans' Memorial Building and the Sonoma County Fair Grounds when public gatherings are being held. Applicant further alleges that the proposed extension would not add appreciably to the present mileage operated nor would it require any additional equipment or change, and that there is no other carrier operating between the points to be served or adjacent thereto. In view of the fact that the Sonoma County Fair commences on July 25, 1952, it is requested that the authority sought be granted as soon as possible and that the required five days published notice be waived.

After full consideration the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the proposed extension. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

An application having been filed, the Commission being fully informed, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the route description as set forth in Decision No. 44935 dated October 24, 1950 in Application No. 31796 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

Route 6 for Operating Convenience Only
Beginning at the intersection of Bennett Avenue and Santa Rosa Avenue, thence along Bennett Avenue to its intersection with Brookwood Avenue.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
