O P I N I O N

This is an application filed by A. L. Riddle pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 6 of the Commission's General Order No. 101 for approval of certificates of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan & Company providing insurance coverage with Lloyd's of London.

A. L. Riddle, doing business as Riddle Scenic Tours, is engaged in conducting sight-seeing operations in the southern part of the state. To meet his obligations for personal liability and property damage he has obtained certificates of insurance providing insurance coverage with Lloyd's in the amounts of \$100,000 and \$300,000 for personal injuries and in the amount of \$10,000 for property damage. The certificates are dated April 21, 1952, and expire March 27, 1953.

It appears that applicant uses one sedan in his operations, and that his operating revenues in California amounted to \$7,082 in 1951. His application shows that there has been but one claim filed during the last three years and that no claims now are pending.

In our opinion the certificates of insurance obtained by applicant should afford security for the protection of the public, as contemplated by the general order.

O R D E R

The Commission having considered the above entitled matter, and being of the opinion that a public hearing thereon is not necessary and that an order should be entered granting applicant's request; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Commission hereby approves the certificates of insurance, dated April 21, 1952, and the endorsements, issued by Cravens, Dargan & Company providing for insurance coverage for A. L. Riddle by Lloyd's of London, and a renewal, or renewals, of said certificates.

2. This order is effective upon the date hereof.
