FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 46736, dated February 13, 1952, the Commission authorized Batteate Livestock Transportation Co., to execute a deed of trust and to issue a \$15,000 note in, or substantially in, the same form as the deed of trust and the note filed by the company as an exhibit attached to its application.

The company now reports that through inadvertence its application indicated that it proposed to issue a note bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum but that the agreed interest rate actually to be charged was 5½%. Accordingly, it has requested the Commission to modify its decision so as to authorize the issue of the note at the 5½% rate.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that the company's request should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The order in Decision No. 46736, dated February 13, 1952, hereby is amended so as to permit Batteate Livestock

Transportation Co., on or before September 30, 1952, to execute its deed of trust and to issue its promissory note in the principal amount of \$15,000 with interest at the rate of 5½% per annum.

2. This first supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
