FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER  
ON REHEARING

Decision No. 47543 issued today in this proceeding authorized Key System to establish increased passenger fares and to provide rules and regulations governing the honoring and redemption of commutation tickets sold prior to the effective date of the fare increases. The order in the decision refers to an erroneous tariff number in connection with the authority to establish the regulations covering the commutation tickets. An appropriate correction will be made. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 47543 of August 5, 1952, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby amended by substituting the phrase "to reissue or amend its tariff" for the phrase "to amend its Tariff Cal.P.U.C. No. 11" appearing in the second line of the second ordering paragraph of the said Decision No. 47543.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects the said Decision No. 47543 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective five (5) days after the date hereof.
