FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 46917, dated April 1, 1952, the Commission authorized Pacific Greyhound Lines to sell certain real property and improvements located in the City of Oakland to Eby Machinery Company, Inc., on or before July 31, 1952.

Applicant has been using the properties for maintenance, repair and storage purposes and it had intended to transfer these activities to a central plant it has been constructing in San Francisco. It had expected to complete the new plant during May, 1952, but it now reports that due to strikes the construction has been delayed and will not be completed until sometime in September. Accordingly, it is not in a position to dispose of the Oakland properties at this time and it has requested an order extending the time limit fixed in the Commission's decision.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Pacific Greyhound Lines may sell the real property and improvements as

authorized by Decision No. 46917, dated April 1, 1952, be, and it hereby is, extended to and including December 31, 1952.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this first supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
