O R D E R

The City of San Bruno, San Mateo County, is authorized to construct Forest Lane at grade across the San Bruno Branch of Southern Pacific Company in that city, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. EM-13.4. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall not be less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on the profile attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G.O. No. 75-3).

Upon completion, Crossing No. EM-13.5 about two hundred and twenty-five feet southerly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
